Ofsted Report

As you will be aware Charville Primary School Academy Trust was inspected by Ofsted on the 25th & 26th April 2017.

We are delighted to share with you the findings of the inspection team and have attached the full report. We expect this to be available on the Ofsted website by the end of this week and will then upload the report on our website. Paper copies of the report are available if you require one.

We are very pleased to be able to report that the school has been graded as GOOD in all areas including overall effectiveness which is a significant improvement from the last inspection which was based on historic pupil attainment.

The school has achieved this by working effectively to identify school priorities and address them quickly to ensure that the impact could be evidenced as soon as possible.

Ofsted identified numerous strengths across the school which include the broad and balanced curriculum, the behaviour and attitudes of the children and the capacity of the leadership team and governors to move the school forward even further.

The team have only identified two areas for development following their rigorous inspection of the school – the first is based on rapid progress of the higher achieving pupils in maths which we have already begun to action and have shared with staff and governors. The second is attendance and for this we need your support.

I will be attending our coffee morning on Wednesday 24th May to discuss this in more detail and it will be the main whole school priority for 2017 – 18, as if this does not improve we will not be able to move the school to a judgement of Outstanding in the future. If you are unable to attend the coffee morning there will also be an opportunity to discuss the report on Wednesday 7th June at 6.00 pm.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for completing the survey and for all the support you have shown the school over the last two years. We look forward to working closely with you to ensure that we address the main issue of attendance.
